Lately it has boosted KHA's educational profile promoting homeopathy case studies, publishing articles & opening to new incomers.




KHA Mission

A safe environment to meet like minded people.


Provide case studies for building knowledge beyond entry-level.



History

Founded in 1991 by professional homeopaths, naturopaths, medical doctors, nurses and other healthcare professionals.

Incorporated in 1992 as a 501c(6) nonprofit.

Defined evaluative criteria for professional homeopathy competence.

Established a Board of Directors representative of the diverse homeopathic community.



Mission

Advance the homeopathic profession by certifying individuals who meet and maintain a recognized standard of professional and ethical competence in classical homeopathy.

Assist the general public in choosing appropriately qualified homeopaths.



Vision

A healthcare system that encompasses certified classical homeopathic practitioners accessible by all.







NCCA Accreditation

In 2017, the CHC was accredited by the National Commission for Certifying Agencies making it the only nationally accredited homeopathy certifying organization in North America.

NCCA accreditation helps ensure the health, welfare and safety of the public.

NCCA third-party validation equates homeopathy with other certified healthcare professions.

NCCA also accredits certified programs for Registered Dieticians, Physician Assistants, Nurse Practitioners, Dental Assistants and more.

What Does the CHC Do?

Certifies...

- Administers and maintains an entry-level competency exam.
- Maintains homeopathy profession standards developed by classical homeopathy stakeholders.

Recertifies...

• Conducts recertification to build knowledge beyond entry-level.



Benefits of Certification

Board-certified achievement designates CCH homeopaths as qualified practitioners.

Profession-building credential promotes greater legal and public recognition of homeopathy.

Established recertification process builds practitioner knowledge beyond entry-level.

CCH-eligible benefits offered by homeopathy community organizations.



CHC Exam

Eligibility:

- 500 hours of homeopathy education*
- 500 hours of homeopathy clinical training*
- College-level Anatomy & Physiology and Human Pathology courses



^{*}Education and training must be from programs accredited by ACHENA or approved by and/or eligible for CHO approval. Non-North American transcripts must be equated.



How can one get CHC Certified?


International homeopathic practitioners outside of the US or Canada, need to submit homeopathy transcript including education and clinical training evaluated and equated including hours studied. Please refer CHC website for Certification Handbook and to evaluation forms.

How can one get CHC Certified?

Once the transcript report has been returned to CHC, they can register for the exam by uploading a copy of the homeopathy transcript and a copy of the equating report.



How can one get CHC Certified?

If the homeopathic practitioner studied within the US or Canada, Their school must be either <u>ACHENA</u> accredited or <u>CHO approved</u> to take the exam.
